Charles R. Eloshway

Charles R. Eloshway is a Patent Attorney in the Office of Intellectual Property Policy and Enforcement (OIPPE) at the United States Patent and Trademark Office (USPTO). Among his duties, Mr. Eloshway represents the United States in multilateral and bilateral negotiations on matters concerning patent law and practice and represents the USPTO in Trilateral Office cooperation efforts. Since 2004, Mr. Eloshway has directed USPTO activities related to office-to-office work-sharing.

Prior to joining OIPPE, Mr. Eloshway was a Patent Examiner at the USPTO for over ten years, and held a variety of other positions, including assignments to the USPTO Solicitor's Office and the Office of Patent Quality Review. During his career at the USPTO, Mr. Eloshway has received several awards, including the Department of Commerce Gold Medal for distinguished service.

Mr. Eloshway is a graduate of the Pennsylvania State University, with a Bachelor of Science degree in Civil Engineering, and the George Washington University, with a Master of Science degree in Civil and Environmental Engineering. Mr. Eloshway received his law degree *cum laude* from the George Washington University Law School, where he was a Dean's Fellow and a member of *The George Washington Law Review*.
